2/20/2007	AB 499	Started out as: minors arrested for prostitution will be treated as victims same as domestic abuse and taken to secure detention center or safe house. If under 18, the person would be placed in civil protective custody on a safety hold and would not be held subject to criminal prosecution or juvenile court proceedings based on the facts giving rise to that placement. Identifies these youth as victims and defines their rights. After series of amendments: bill became a two-year pilot project for the District Attorney of Alameda Co. The program is contingent upon local funding and is for the purposes of developing a comprehensive, replicative, multidisciplinary model to address the needs and effective treatment of commercially sexually exploited minors	Swanson	Chaptered	9/27/2008
