California Against Slavery would like to ask permission to collect signatures outside of your door from those who are your customers.

This petition will place on the ballot a proposition that will strengthen human trafficking laws in California. It includes the following:

- Increased jail time of traffickers
- Increase victim's rights
- Distribution of trafficker's forfeited assets/fines to victim's services/organizations
- Mandatory 2-hour human trafficking training for law enforcement

We are an organization that recognizes human trafficking* exists in the United States – at least 100,000 enslaved and 17,000 people are brought in to the U.S. as human trafficking victims every year. California is a hot spot because of its international borders, large economy, ports, and metropolitan regions. We are greatly concerned for all victims, and especially concerned about the exploitation of children.

We greatly appreciate your support of Children's Miracle Network to raise money for children's hospitals. Children... that's what we care about too. This initiative will help to end human trafficking and child exploitation in California. We would like to work together with IHOP in saving children.
